

Women Against Rape

WAR was started by a young woman who had been raped and abused, but had brought her life together again, and decided to assist rape victims.

WAR works through Police Stations when women come in to open a case of rape. Each victim is given a comfort pack consisting of a number of items which should help to give comfort in the crisis situation.

The packs cost about R100 each. In each pack is a mostly hand knitted teddy bear, made to a pattern developed a number of years ago for such a purpose.

The Anns of Pretoria East and their friends have knitted most of the teddy bears, and they donate the money to buy the rest of the items.
