

SOUNDS literacy project



The Rotary Club of Pretoria East started its first Global Grant SOUNDS project in 2011 in five schools in Mamelodi. Since then a second Global grant has allowed the club to expand the project by placing over 400 sets.

Based on targeting 35 pupils per classroom, about 14 000 pupils are reached each year. Current stock levels are down to only nine (9) SOUNDS sets. Robin Jones who is spearheading this project is now looking into the local manufacturing of SOUNDS sets by means of 3D printing and laser cutting.

Despite local manufacturing being investigated, Robin has nevertheless brushed up on the requirements of importation clearance and is now a registered import agent. Congratulations Robin!!!
