

# WINTERVELDT HIV/AIDS PROJECT

Winterveldt HIV/AIDS Project (WHAP) was established in 1988 as a non-profit Section 21 company. Winterveldt is the poorest township in Gauteng and has a population of 750 000 people of which 70% are unemployed.

WHAP is a home-based care organisation aimed at providing quality care, support and counselling to the terminally ill due to Aids and TB. Today 5 staff and 51 caregivers.

## WHAT RCPE has done for WHAP:

- Providing monthly food parcels for AVR and Orphan & Vulnerable children
- Paid running costs

- Computers, printers and ink
- Blankets
- Shoes
- Wheelchairs
- School uniforms
- Built a 4-unit toilet block using local labour
- A brick office block consisting of meeting room and store
- 100m<sup>2</sup> Steel shed using a local contractor
- A security fence using a local contractor
- Upgrading the site electrical system

The Winterveldt HIV/AIDS Project is a small organisation with a big heart that impacts its community in a powerful way.
