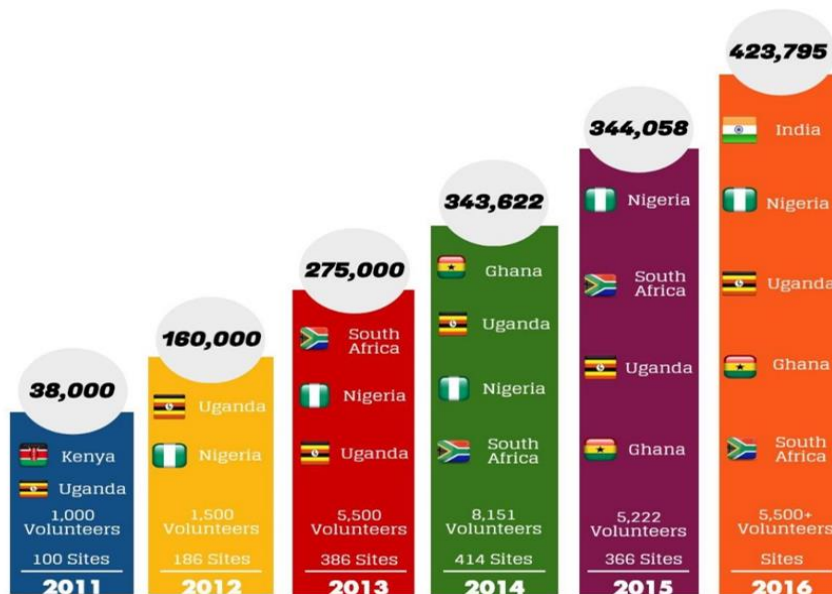


Rotary Family Health Days



The Rotary Family Health Days (RFHD) will take place from the 3rd to the 5th of October 2017.

- Launch Site: Mpumalanga - 3rd October
- All 9 Provinces in South Africa
- 120 sites (40 per Rotary District)
- 100 000 patients expected



The RFHD is a Pan African and Indian initiative and a Public/Private Partnership programme.

It is an immense and impactful, Rotary-led health campaign held nationwide over three days in multiple African countries and India.

It provides comprehensive free health care and screening services to citizens at selected sites – rural, urban and informal identified by partners.

In 2016 some 39,689 people were treated by 138 Rotary Clubs in the three Rotary districts of South Africa.

- District 9400: 15, 659
- District 9370: 11, 594
- District 9350: 12, 436

The total number of health services provided, amounted to 142,105.

Since the inception of RFHD in 2011 up to February 2017, altogether 1,584,475 beneficiaries have been served free healthcare by Rotarians and partners.
