

Johannesburg International Flower and Garden Show

Our club is raising funds for World Polio Day. Although Rotary commemorates World Polio Day on the 24th of October, our club decided to incorporate this into our exhibit at the Johannesburg International Flower and Garden Show from 30 October until 3 November because Africa is on the brink of becoming a Polio free zone.
