

RCPE RAFFLE raises R4 200

AT the Johannesburg International Flower and Garden Show

RCPE raised funds for World Polio Day and other club projects at our exhibit at the Johannesburg International Flower and Garden Show from 30 October until 3 November.

The RAFFLE raised a total of R4 200.

There were four prizes with a total value of R12 500, namely a two- and a one-night stay for 2 people at a hotel (value R6 000 and R3 000 respectively), a cycad with a permit (value R2 000) and 18-year old Islay single malt scotch whisky (value R1 500). Altogether 1200 Raffle tickets were prepared and packaged in 24 books of 50 tickets each. The raffle tickets were sold at R50 each with the potential of raising R60 000. The lucky tickets were drawn at the RCPE club meeting on 11 November. Unfortunately, no photos are available, but the winners are as follows:

Fundraising for the club contribution to EndPolioNow via donations and also for Infotoons jointly raised R 1 370.

There were also 160 vegetable production Infotoons at a donation of R20 each (= R320)
